THANK YOU FOR PURCHASING A MUSICMAKERS KINDER HARP!

We include songsheets that slide under the strings for playing simple melodies with the diatonic tuning. Just fold or cut the corners and align the page under the strings so the horizontal lines match the strings. Then pluck the notes shown from left to right to play the melody. Notice that one song sheet is left blank so you can photocopy it for writing out more songs of your own choosing.

This instrument also works well for creating sound effects for storytelling. We can provide you with a list of fun sounds you can make on the instrument, making it very useful for working with children in a school setting, library story hour, children's hospital, or family gatherings. The Kinder Harp is a great tool for calming children down at bed time by playing Lullabies or telling bed-time stories. Check our web site for more information and ideas.

GENERAL CARE

If you just remember that your instrument is generally comfortable in the same environment you are, you will be fine. Prolonged exposure to extreme temperatures can and will damage your instrument. Mostly this means that you don't want to leave your Kinder Harp in your car for much more than an hour on a very hot or very cold day.

Your Kinder Harp is finished with a water-based varnish which is durable, long lasting, and environmentally friendly. We recommend Old English furniture cleaner and polish for regular maintainance and hiding scratches.

If you use your harp in a clinical setting and need to sanatize the surface between patients, most any of the the sterilizing wipes will work.. The hydrogen peroxide based wipes, such as the Oxivar TB Wipes, tend to be gentler on the finish.

IF A STRING BREAKS...

You can order replacement strings from Musicmakers or you may be able to find individual strings at your local music store. Ask for monofilament nylon strings or ball-end acoustic strings if you have the wire set. See the attached string charts to get the correct size string.

TUNING

The Kinder Harp is tuned to the key of G major which has one sharp "F" note in each octave. All this means is that the bottom note (G3, or G below Middle C) is Do in a do-re-mi scale and that you must tune your Fs to F-sharp. Use our free online keyboard to get a reference pitch:



<u>NOTE</u>: Nylon strings take longer to stretch and stabilize than steel, so we recommend tuning nylon 3-4 times a day for the first week to hasten the process.
