



Instructions For Use

1. Cut out the template along the black line.
2. Place the template under strings. The gray lines should sit just below the stings.

Note: Every harp is handmade so the strings may not line up perfectly, but they should be close enough.

3. Tune the harp to the notes on the tuning chart.

The number next to each note name indicates the octave.

Middle C on a piano is C4. The numbers change every octave on the note C.

C3 is the C one octave below middle C.

D4 is the D just above Middle C.

C5 is the C one octave above middle C
